




#### Number of UAC per accommodation type

## UAC analysis per accommodation type

Total: 2,131 persons



\* The National Emergency Response Mechanism for unaccompanied minors in precarious living conditions launched the telephone line in April 2021 and assumed the accommodation of unaccompanied minors in June of the same year. Until the end of August, the Mechanism received 1,460 calls, which concern 1,154 different cases of unaccompanied minors, out of which 1,122 concern accommodation requests, 24 legal aid, and 8 other requests.








#### Monthly UAC referrals to EKKA by Nationality
